

8 Easy Tricks for Poker Players



Poker is still the most gambling game in the world. It is possible to play poker, both in life and on the Internet, for example on [PlayAmo Casino](#). And each branch has its own tricks.

But let's look at tricks in classic hold'em, when poker is played at the table. The tricks are more of a psychological nature and apply to amateurs. But they will take you to the pros.

Bankroll Management

This is the basis of poker accounting, which involves the competent management of money allocated to poker. The task of the player is to distribute investments. So, they allow the mathematical expectation and avoid bankruptcy. In other words, the player has to follow certain rules.

He should play on those limits, on which the size of the capital allows the game comfortably. When landing at the table, the poker player must leave the means on the account, which would allow continuing to play in case the mathematical expectation is not realized.

For example, if he enters the table with a \$5 stack, he must have on the account at least \$250. This reserve will allow playing a long session, and the more hands the poker player plays, the more profitable decisions will bring profit.

In addition, losing a small part of the bankroll will not affect the player's psychological state and will not cause tilt. The ratio of bankroll to limit can be different.

Experienced players calculate it, based on the knowledge of the peculiarities of their game. Beginners are recommended to have capital of at least 50 buy-ins to play at the cash tables.

Player Personality = Character in Poker

Take a look at [how the player's chips are laid out](#). If they are spaced out, he is a risk-taker. The person is in the best possible mood for the game.

Expect an aggressive strategy with a bluff. And if the chips are neatly stacked, then this is a cautious player. He is conservative, there should be no bluffing.

You can also play with him carefully, there is no reason to expect them to cheat.

Pay Attention to the Protracted Timing of the Game

If in the process of betting, the player destroys chips and then collects them, this is a sign. The player is procrastinating because he is bluffing. Such a person himself is worried and thinks that if his chips are not perfect, he will be suspected.

Watch Others on the Flop

When the second round occurs and the first 3 cards open, don't look at them right away. Rather, look around and assess the

behavior of the other players. That way you can identify what combinations the other players want to make.

The flop itself will be lying around for a while longer. You'll have time for everything!

If you have seen someone turn away from the flop (usually eyes to the side), it means a strong combination. Taking a long look at 3 common cards or one's own cards, he has a weak combination. If a person looks at the chips, then there is a strong combination. Have you seen that someone checks the cards? That is, just looked and closed the cards. Then this player checks the suit. And, most likely, he has a flush.

Remember Your Cards

You can't look at your own cards, you have to remember them. Yes, remember not only their strength but also their suit. If you look at your cards from the second round on, the other players will easily notice this and guess your future combinations.

It's hard to remember your cards the first time. You need to practice. But as experienced players say, this skill will save you a lot of money.

Don't Be Fooled by External Indicators of Weakness

Any sighing, smacking, shrugging shoulders – it seemed to mean the person was doing badly. But it doesn't. In poker, if a player is bad, he will try not to show it so obviously. But those who have good cards and strong combinations do it on purpose, hoping that they will cheat others.

Nervousness Is Not a Bluff

If a player suddenly gets nervous, it's not a bluff, as most people think. It means that the person has a strong combination. The pressure has spiked, so the hands may be shaking as well.

Recognize the Bluff

This can be done easily. When the player moves, touch your chips. The player doesn't move and continues to make his move as well? He has a strong combination. But if the player hesitates, he's bluffing.

If you apply at least a few of these techniques, you'll notice how your level of play has improved. But remember, there are exceptions to the rules.
